# WE NEED TO TALK ABOUT ... CONSTIPATION

Constipation can be a life-threatening issue for people with a learning disability who are at heightened risk from complications if it is left untreated.

In fact, 23% of people with a learning disability who died in 2019 had constipation as a long-term condition. In North Yorkshire 34% of people on the Learning Disabilities Register have constipation as a co-morbidity.

People with a learning disability may also be less likely to recognise the symptoms of constipation and be able to communicate their symptoms, increasing the risk of serious consequences.

# FOCUS ON RESPIRATORY DISEASE

Respiratory disease is one of the biggest causes of death for people with a learning disability in England but many of these deaths are avoidable.

Incidence and mortality rates for those with respiratory disease are higher in disadvantaged groups and areas of social deprivation, and people with a learning disability are no exception to this.

Pneumonia, and particularly aspiration pneumonia, is a prominent cause of death in people with a learning disability. Up to 15% of all respiratory deaths reported were caused by aspiration pneumonia in 2021. People with a learning disability can have a one-off pneumococcal vaccination.

## FOCUS ON POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT (PBS)

Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) is about working in partnership with people, treating them with dignity and respect and enabling them have a better life.

#### All behaviours have a meaning!

Positive Behaviour Support aims to understand what behaviours that challenge tell us so that the person's needs can be met in better ways. The way the person is supported often has to change to achieve this and this needs to be regularly reviewed by all the people involved.

Positive Behaviour Support is an approach that puts the person at the centre to make systems work for the person. We give the right support at the right time so people can thrive to their potential.
